#### 3. Temperature Taking Exercise – Wednesday, 29 June 2022

Conducted twice per year, the temperature-taking exercise aims to maintain schools' preparedness to reactivate the temperature-taking regime should there be a need to. It also serves to educate students on taking personal responsibility for their own health and practising social responsibility.

The temperature-taking exercise will be conducted on **Wednesday**, **29 June 2022**.

As part of the school's preparation for the exercise, we will be conducting a pre-exercise check on the students' Oral Digital Thermometers (ODTs) on **Tuesday**, **28 June 2022**. We would like to seek your assistance in ensuring that your child/ward brings his/her personal ODT on the day mentioned.

# 4. Tinkerlution Challenge - Friday, 15 July 2022

For Tinkerlution Challenge this year, students will take part in various hands-on activities that will spark curiosity and require them to apply thinking and problem-solving skills. Based on their respective levels, students will explore activities that include upcycling, creating ball launchers and tinkering with electronics. While teachers put on the hat of "Facilitator", students lead the way as "Tinkerneers" engaging in creative exploration and learning.

### 5. Mother Tongue Language (MTL) Fortnight - Monday, 18 July 2022 to Friday, 22 July 2022

This year, the Mother Tongue Language (MTL) Fortnight would be conducted for all MTL students in the school in two parts. The first part was introduced in Term 1 during the Chinese New Year period with various cultural activities. The second part will be conducted this term from 18 July 2022 to 22 July 2022. A variety of activities will be conducted within the classrooms to provide platforms for our students to actively learn about and appreciate culture so as to experience MTL as a 'living language'.

#### 6. Racial Harmony Day - Commemorating on Tuesday, 19 July 2022

The theme for Racial Harmony Day this year is "Singapore: Our Multicultural Mosaic".

This year's Racial Harmony Day theme focuses on the appreciation of the diverse races and religions that make up our multicultural society and contribute to our shared sense of cohesion and harmony.

In line with the school's core values, students will understand the importance of values like respect and empathy in their daily interactions with others. Lessons for lower primary will focus on building friendships with people from all ethnic communities in age-appropriate ways. For upper primary students, they will learn about standing up against unkind words and actions and appreciating the diversity across cultures. Students will explore what it means to strengthen connection amongst communities and to take action to preserve racial harmony in Singapore.

#### 7.P6 Preliminary Oral Examination – Monday, 25 July & Wednesday, 27 July 2022

The P6 will be having their Preliminary Oral Examinations on Monday, 25 July and Wednesday, 27 July 2022. Candidates will be informed of their estimated dismissal times closer to the date. The schedule will closely follow the PSLE sequence of testing to familiarise candidates with the actual flow of the PSLE Oral Examinations. Hence, candidates will be grouped into 2 sessions (Session 1 and Session 2) for each testing day, based on their PSLE arrangement.

- Session 1: After being tested, candidates will move to a Quarantine Room. They will be dismissed only when all Session 1 candidates have been tested and all Session 2 candidates are accounted for.
- Session 2: Candidates will be dismissed after being tested.

As most teachers will be involved in the examination, all afternoon activities for the other levels will be cancelled with the exception of the following:

- P3 and P4 SDR sessions

### 8.P6 Preliminary Listening Comprehension Examination – Tuesday, 2 August 2022

The P6 Preliminary Listening Comprehension examination is scheduled for 2 August 2022 from 1.30pm to 4.45pm. Candidates not taking Mother Tongue Languages will be dismissed at 3.30pm. All afternoon classes and activities will be cancelled for the day.
